Artistic Development Grant Application

The Chequamegon Bay Arts Council (CBAC) announces its sixth annual artistic development grant. The purpose of this grant is to promote ongoing learning and to encourage area residents to further their artists abilities for reasons of personal growth and enhanced community artistic excellence.

Eligible Applicants

Any professional, amateur or student artist residing in Ashland or Bayfield counties is eligible to apply.

Expenses Eligible for funding

Short-term courses pertaining to an artistic field of interest of the applicant are eligible. Short term is defined as fewer than 15 class sessions. Workshops and art/music camps are also eligible. Awarded funds may not be applied to college tuition for regular classes where the applicant is attending. Short-term courses offered by a college are eligible. Well-defined individual research projects of an artistic nature are also eligible. Awarded funds may cover course registration fees, materials, and travel.

Criteria

Criteria to be applied in evaluating grant applications include:

- individual benefit
- educational merit
- financial need demonstrated by applicant
- community benefit

Grant Award

Number of grants awarded will be determined after applications are received. At least \$1,500 of total funding is available. Applicants should demonstrate financial commitment to their project. CBAC will not fund the entire cost of any project.
